Requirements

- store data for the forms for retrieval for revisiting the page or for completing the form
- enable multiple instances of a form
- enable re-ordering of forms

A Django style way of doing things

- Take the form and supply it the data from the request
- Unique Id passed via get, generated by form
- A dict of dicts is used to store the data
- Slug based titles are used to access the page
- Page descriptor wrapper
 - defaults
 - complete_page
 - render page - redirect
- Dynamic Structure
